The Motion Reads as Follows:

To appropriate up to \$500 to to transfer our phoneline form call experts to twilio.

Intent: To finally get rid of call experts and stop paying for two phonelines. We have moved to a new phone system that will cost us much less than \$100 a year and has meeting lookup capability thats tied to the Carolina Region meeting database. Currently we are forwarding our number to this new service while still paying a little over \$30 a month, monthly costs for the new service has been less than \$5 a month. By transferring this number we will save the area well over \$200 a year. We hope to negotiate the \$500 cost down but if we can this should get done as its silly to be paying for two services. The new service is called YAP and makes use of twilio which is a Phone VoIP API.
