**CRNA RD Report
October 12th, 2019
Weddington, NC**

Hello Family,

First, I would like to welcome everyone to the Carolina Region Service Committee (CRSC). The RCM orientation and Service day in Rockhill, SC was filled with lots of information, Thank you to all who joined us. RCM's that did not receive the NEW RCM Guide or New CRNA Policy, please see the policy chair or me on break. Please, read them both. You as the RCM's are the "Voting Body"; you make all the Decisions and hold the Admin accountable to their roles and responsibilities. Reminder: RCM's you are the Board of Directors for CRNA nonprofit 501c3 corporation.

SEZF: The July, 2019 South Eastern Zonal Form (SEZF) was held in Huntington, Alabama. CRNA RD, brought a discussion to SEZF floor; Reference the unacceptable spending of regions funds this weekend, 5 of the 6 regions agreed, (Very poorly planned with SZF (Texas) business meeting on Zoom being only item on agenda other than SEZF business meeting on Sunday). Final decision; have a planned agenda by hosting region and/or zone in advance for SEZF to be more productive and financially responsible with each Regions NA funds.

Sundays, SEZF business meeting proposals:

- The SEZF Budget passed. (Each regions donation is \$1,166.67 Annually, \$3,333.34 Bi-Annually)
- The SEZF Guideline Failed. (There was a straw poll, CRNA voted no, and CRNA's many questions (on pages 45 & 46 of SEZF minutes) were addressed, after discussion 3 regions agreed. An Ad-hoc was formed to discuss and change SEZF Guideline financial part with members of CRNA finance/policy and SFR finance/policy, Neal SEZF treasurer as the facilitator)
- The creation of a Local Services Workgroup passed
- The SEZF voted to purchase a SEZF ZOOM account, not continue to pay for a license under NWAFR, with access to only 2 of the 3 accounts.
- The very first WSC Virtual meeting of all the Zones in the world was held on September 14th, 2109, Please see the attached WSC Zonal Virtual meeting report .
- ***Question for the Regions: What is the vision of our Zones future, i.e.: Fellowship Development a resource or another level of service or something else?***

For more detailed information, Please see The SEZF minutes in the Secure Document Portal in the New RD/AD folder. CRNA is hosting the SEZF, December 6-8, 2019, which will also be the first CAR workshop in our Region.

Motion from CRNA: The motion that this body directed the RD to submit: Directing the WB to have a project plan for an SP, explaining "Being Under No Surveillance at Anytime". WSC-2020 CAR motion has been completed after lengthy discussions and misunderstandings. The final CRNA and World Board (WB) draft is attached. Please, let your areas/groups know this motion will be in the CAR, WSC-2020.

Email and Packet: *There was an email sent with an overview of some items that have been released for CAR/CAT 2020, which included information referring to the Fellowship Intellectual Property Trust (FIPT). I do have a packet available for each area of changes proposed to FIPT, please see me on break. The FIPT is available at na.org/FIPT. Please review the changes very careful and send all questions, thoughts, concerns or requests for a presentation to the RD (rd@crna.org).*

CAR/CAT: The release dates for the Conference Agenda Report (CAR) is November 26th, 2019 and the CAT is January 23rd for the RD and AD; November 29th CAR, January 26th CAT, will be available on na.org/conference. So, CRNA (RD/AD) is preparing to do CAR CAT presentations in your Areas, in the past WSC cycles, multi-group-multi-Areas united together to be prudent and financially responsible. Below are some thoughts on areas near each other:

(Charlotte, Borderline, KISS, GCANA, S. Foothills, C. Piedmont, L. Norman)
(Catawba, Capital, New Hope, Twin City, Western Carolina
(Port City, South Coastal, Coastal Car., Pee Dee, Sun City)
(GAP, North Central, USCANA, Greater Columbia, Central Carolina,)

We will have a WSC-2020 folder in the SDP to include a recording of the CAR and a recording of the CAT with factual answers to some of the most frequently asked questions. The RD has been discussing with the web team having a plug-in on the SDP for voting on the CAR/CAT, SFR and Alabama used on-line voting, so it's only in the discussion stages. The voting process will be discussed in January at the CRSC; basically it will be the same as the last few cycles. So, please talk to your Areas about hosting, time and dates that work best for you. Keep in mind that all votes are due no later than the CRSC in April.

The Carolina Region (CRNA) is hosting the SEZF and CAR workshop weekend, on December 6th – 8th, 2019, at Fairfield / Residence Inn, located at 2220 West Tyvola Rd, Charlotte, NC. This launches the first Carolina Regions CAR workshop on the 7th day of December, 8:30 am to 1 pm.; immediately following the lunch break there are some exciting presentations. Including, The Additional Needs Liaison giving a presentation, as well as answering any questions your Area/Groups may have. There is so much excitement for all the Scheduled presentations, please see the attached agenda and distribute to all your areas/groups/members. December 8th same location, is the SEZF business meeting from 8 am to 1 pm. Reminder: there will be one CAR/Cat available per area. If you would like more you may download them at www.na.org/conference.

Proposal: Attached is a proposal to be brought back to your Areas, The proposal is to adopt the additional needs guidelines to CRNA, attached are the guidelines. The only changes to them would be, Carolina Region would be in place of SFR and the North and South Carolina laws would be put in place of the Florida Laws. NAWS: The Annual Report has been released, na.org/ar-2018. The financial statements provide a written record of NAWS' financial condition.

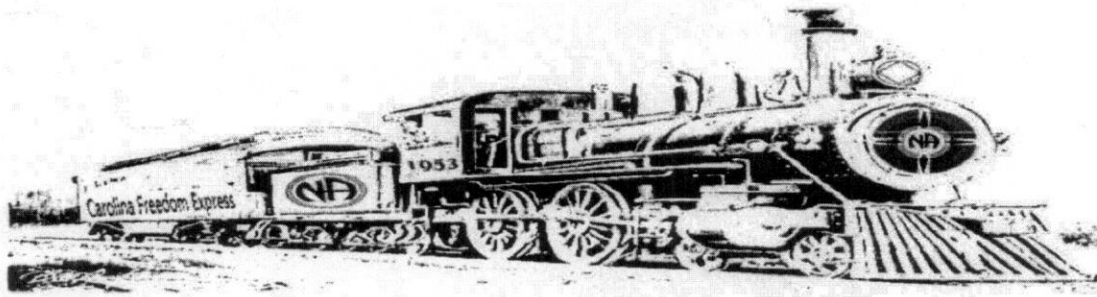
