SCASC RCM Report
June 13, 2021

Once again, there has been virtually no service activity at the regional level, that I have been made aware of, since our April SCASC meeting.

This will be our last ASC meeting before the July CRSC meeting. There are 3 proposals to be considered at that meeting.

Proposal 21-04-02 would add to regional policy a change that: suggests "that a portion of the meetings be held in person in order to promote fellowship and unity throughout the region." My input is to not adopt this proposal. It is too vague and nonsensical. If those in attendance are going to participate in the RSC meeting, there would be no need to have the balance of the meeting virtually. Virtual meetings have been very productive and sticking with that format would save a lot of money and our most valuable resource, time.

Proposal 21-04-05 would establish a process for regional consideration of nominees seeking world services positions. Our current policy does not have a process for this.

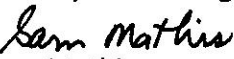
The Carolina Region budget will be considered in July. My recommendation is to approve the budget. I would appreciate any feedback on the budget.

I have made a proposal that all CRSC meeting be held virtually. My perspective is that one of the most profound effects of the pandemic on NA is that we have discovered that there is more participation by areas at the regional level and that a considerable amount of money and time have been saved.

I want to take this opportunity to remind you that the Lowcountry Mental Health Conference is coming up July 28-30, 2021, at the Gaillard Performance Center, 95 Calhoun St., Charleston, SC 29401. The CRSC PR subcommittee is registered as an exhibitor and will be delivering a lunchtime panel session about "Narcotics Anonymous and the Benefits of Recovery." The regional PR subcommittee is also preparing video segments which can either be used to deliver a fully virtual session or used as part of the overall presentation.

Person(s) seeking a recommendation and/or nomination from the Carolina Region for world service position should submit a proposal requesting a recommendation at the regular CRSC meeting for consideration and discussion by the RCMs. If the decision is made to recommend the candidate, the RD will forward the recommendation with attached application to the World Services Human Resources Panel. It will be up to the RCMs to determine if they desire to take a proposal back to their respective Areas.

Modifications (if any):

Intent:

To be consistent with Guide to World Services Policy and provide a mechanism to make recommendations and nominations from the Carolina Region. Here is a more detailed explanation:

The "RBZ" Process

The RBZ (regions, World Board, zones) recommendation process provides regions, the World Board, and zones a system for identifying and forwarding potential candidates for World Service positions to the Human Resource Panel. This is separate from and after the HRP's initial screening process.

It is important to note that an RBZ recommendation is not a nomination. The RBZ process foregoes the HRP's initial screening and ensures that the RBZ candidate will receive an HRP interview.

Four phases of the RBZ Process are:

- Regions, the World Board and zones (RBZs) are sent an announcement from the HRP, explaining the opportunity to forward names of potential candidates for world service level trusted servants.
- Those individuals whose names are forwarded by the regions, World Board and zones are notified and asked to submit or update their World Pool Information.
- As a part of their interview process, the HRP interviews each RBZ candidate and conducts reference checks.
- As a part of the HRP's final nomination process, RBZs are included for consideration for nomination at the World Service Conference.

Nominations From Conference Participants

Seated regions can make a nomination, and conference participants can make or second nominations.

- These nominations require a second by another conference participant.

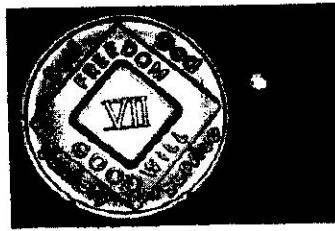

CHECKLIST FOR REOPENING MEETINGS

It is suggested that groups have a detailed plan for reopening in-person meetings. As NA groups, we need to keep our Traditions in mind (paraphrased here):

4th Tradition – Groups are autonomous, *except when our actions may affect other groups or NA as a whole.*

10th Tradition – We have no opinion on outside issues, and so should *avoid being drawn into public controversy.*

12th Tradition – We should practice *spiritual principles in all our affairs*, including selflessness, responsibility, trustworthiness and compassion.

Below are items groups should take into consideration when planning to reopen, and suggestions for addressing them:

- ☐ Have we visited the websites to CDC and state/local guidelines to be sure we are in compliance with them?
- ☐ Have we spoken to the facility; do we have permission to meet where we rent? Does the facility have any specific requirements that must be adhered to when using the facilities going forward?
- ☐ Do we have plans for sanitizing before and after the meeting?
 - Clean all tables and chairs before members arrive; and after members leave.
 - Have spray cleaner and paper towels available for those who want to clean their own areas.
 - Make sure that restrooms (if open) have soap for washing hands.
- ☐ Have we thought about ways to encourage personal safety?
 - Wear your masks/face coverings to meetings.
 - Consider not serving coffee, and suggest that members bring their own drinks.
 - Have hand sanitizer available if possible.
- ☐ Do we have a socially distant seating plan?
 - Move chairs to allow for space between members.
 - Consider designating a separate area for members with compromised immune systems – could use “reserved” signs on seats; make sure the designated space is away from high-traffic areas.
- ☐ Are we prepared to take every precaution we can during the meeting?
 - **Readings:** Download readings/books/IPs to avoid passing literature around the meeting.
 - **Contributions:** Put the basket in a stationary place; or consider using a money app for donations.
 - Have gloves and sanitizer available for anyone **signing papers**.
 - Spray **keytags** with disinfectant prior to the meeting; wear gloves when handing them out.
 - Create electronic versions of **phone lists**, or exchange phone numbers via text.
 - Refer attendees to websites or apps for **meeting schedules** instead of using paper lists.
 - **Circle up without touching**, and maintain physical distance.
- ☐ Have we thought about ways to accommodate those not yet able to meet in person due to health or other concerns? (Example: hybrid-virtual/physical meeting)
- ☐ Have we come up with a plan on how to handle situations where we may have an overflow in attendance?
 - Is there a completely separate space we have permission to use? (A large group, divided within a single room or space, is still a large group)
- ☐ Have we carefully considered how reopening our meeting will affect our public image?
 - Communicate with members and the public (as needed) about the precautions the group is taking to protect the safety of meeting attendees and the public as a whole.
 - Add an announcement in the meeting format to clearly state and reiterate the precautions being taken to protect members.
